Overview

I will start playing *Nimrod* a couple of minutes before the bell. I aim to finish this as the wreath is laid.

The following may, or may not, take place: **When the Celebrant arrives at the altar he receives the flag from each of the uniformed groups, and finally receives and places the wreath in front of the altar. Once the wreath is in place and all have moved away I will play (no trumpet this year) the *Last Post*. This is followed by two minutes silence, which concludes with me paying *Reveille*.**

IMMEDIATELY after Reveille the Choir sings the *Introit* (*Requiem aeternam....*) whilst the Celebrant incenses the altar, and then IMMEDIATELY sings the *Kyrie*.

After the *Introit*, the Celebrant reads the *Collect*, and Mass continues as normal.

The *Credo*, *Memorial Acclamation* and *Pater Noster* are all spoken.
