ADVANCE NOTICE OF SCHOOL REFERENCES FOR 2020 ENTRY

Please keep an eye out for information on references, including dates and times of interviews with Fr Deo.

There are various circumstances under which you may need a reference. Apart from moving to a completely new school, remember that you will also need a reference for moving within the same group of schools; for placing or keeping children on waiting lists; for in-year transfers between schools at the same level. If you know or think that any of these circumstances will or could possibly apply to you, please ensure that you seek an interview. Parish Priests are always asked to provide details of Catholic practice for parents/guardians and children for a period of three years. If you are new to the parish, or if you have not been here for that long, you must seek a reference from your previous Parish Priest. If you attend Mass at different parishes, such as those which cater for particular language groups, again you must seek references from them too. Would all parents and guardians please share this information with those who might not see the newsletter or the parish web site.
