ANNUAL BLESSING OF GRAVES AT STREATHAM PARK CEMETERY, ROWAN ROAD TODAY

The annual blessing of graves will take place this afternoon at 3pm sharp. Car parking is available. Follow the path by the office to the end, and turn left, where we shall gather beside the new tombs. Please be prepared for wet weather, and kindly look out for one another, since there will be a lot of traffic. Some priests from neighbouring parishes are expected to attend. There will be a short service, with a general blessing of graves. Subject to both time and weather, clergy will be happy to bless individual graves. Please have consideration for our priests who may have to get back to say evening Masses, in addition to which, the cemetery closes promptly at 4pm as darkness falls.
