

Information and forms are available for the Gift Aid scheme. Both Gift Aiders and non-Gift Aiders are asked to consider a standing order to help us in our budgeting.

Whether you are currently a member of the Gift Aid Scheme, or considering joining it, you are advised to check your tax position with HMRC to ensure that you pay sufficient tax in relation to Gift Aid. The golden rule is: 'If in doubt, leave it out!'
