UNWANTED NOTES, COINS AND CURRENCY

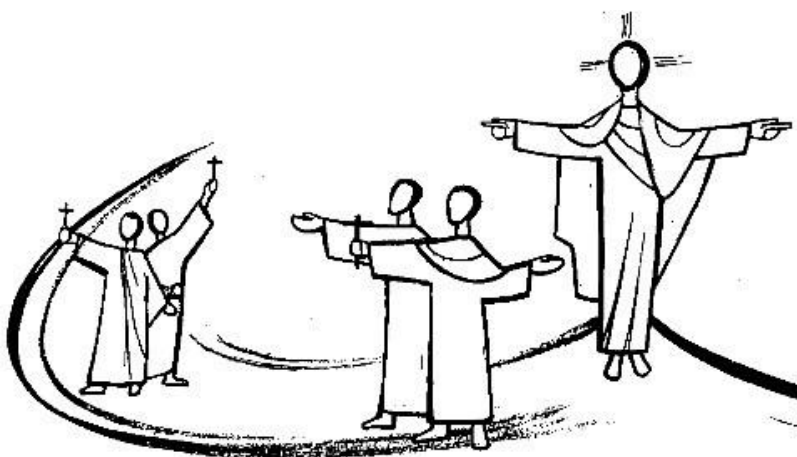
Please deposit any old notes and coins, including UK and foreign
