There are a number of Saturdays in the coming months, when
A Day With Mary will be held in various parishes. Please take
time to check the posters in the porch, in case there might be an
event which you could attend in honour of our Blessed Mother.

OUR LADY IN OUR PARISH

Apart from the various celebrations in the Church honouring Our
Lady, please note that on most Saturdays outside of Easter and
Christmas, Masses of the Blessed Virgin Mary are celebrated at
10am. The Rosary is recited daily in our parish, with Benediction
taking place on most Sundays at 4pm, except on Sundays in Lent
when we have the Stations of the Cross. Our Lady has her own
chapel and altar at the front of the church, to the right hand side.
There one may pause for prayer, to ask Our Lady for her loving
help and support, and perhaps to thank her for favours received,
remembering that Mary our Mother, the Mother of God, intercedes
for us to her Beloved Son, Jesus. You may also remember a motto
of Pope St John Paul, "To Jesus Through Mary".

There are also many books available from the Catholic Truth
Society and others (see the rack outside the Repository) on various
aspects of Our Lady, who has many titles afforded to her.

It is most important to remember that we when pray to Our Lady,
we are not placing her above her Son, but honouring her as our
Blessed Mother and asking for her to intercede on our behalf.
Indeed, when Our Lady appeared to St Bernadette of Lourdes, and
as she moved through her Rosary beads, Mary remained silent
during each Hail Mary, as her role was and is to point the way
towards Jesus and not to seek or receive any praise herself, nor to
attribute any glory to herself. The Church remains grateful for the
"Yes" from Mary to the Angel Gabriel, at the Annunciation.

There are many beautiful prayers to or connected to Our Lady,
many of which you will find in the Simple Prayer Book.
These include: The Magnificat; the Memorare; The Most Holy
Rosary; the Hail Holy Queen; the Regina Caeli. Why not take a
look and get to know Our Lady a little better each day?
