SPUC PETITION RELATING TO THE TWO CHILD BENEFIT CAP

Today is the annual pro-life petition day for SPUC (The Society for the Protection of Unborn Children.) This year's petition focuses on the two-child benefit cap, which you will have heard about recently in the news. Sadly, one of the biggest drivers of abortion in the UK is **poverty**, and one particular policy which penalises families and contributes to poverty is the current government policy on Universal Benefits.
